Rick Gillespie a long-time American activist, who was joined by his son this day, spoke as a founder and on how important it is to address racism, which is an integral component of war, explaining that he realized he had some racists tendency only after reading the book 'Me and White Supremacy':

NATO/UKRAINE/RUSSIA—WHERE IS THE TRUTH?

Wow, the bombs and guns do not go silent, ever! Somewhere in our world someone is dying, someone's home is being destroyed, someone is wounded, and someone has lost a loved one to violence, to war. The list of unnecessary 'human' created tragedy never ends.

Do you ever wonder why? Why is there such violence in our world? Why is there so much war? Why is it acceptable to kill and maim and destroy under the banner of a nation or military alliance? Why is it acceptable to pour billions of dollars into the weapons industry, whether conventional, uranium tipped bullets, biological or nuclear? Why is it such an honour to organize, to learn how to kill, to commit murder, to destroy as long as it's approved by government or an alliance such as NATO? There seem to be a lack of funds for universal health, dental, mental and pharmaceutical care? There are never funds for the poor, the disabled to come out of the cycle of poverty? There are no funds to transition to renewable, sustainable energy. But, there are always funds for war, threats and preparations for war, for invasion, occupation, regime change.

Sadly, the only conflict grabbing the attention of the world is Ukraine. But they have and continue to do so. This has been an ongoing struggle between the West and the East since the early 1990s. The former Yugoslavia was broken apart by NATO. It was NATO and the USA that created the Mujahedeen that became the Taliban and precipitated the break-up of the Soviet Union; it was NATO and the USA who invaded Iraq not once but twice and then proceeded into Afghanistan, destroying both nations that were on the path to democracy based on a socialist model. So, why would Russia want NATO that was instituted to 'battle the red scourge' and stop Communism, to encroach itself right to its doorstep? Would you? What happened when Cuba became a Communist nation and the Soviet Union put in a naval base and transported nuclear weapons to the island? Well, that was a close call. The world did not sink into another nuclear holocaust simply because Kennedy and Krushev took a deep breath, a second look and did not listen to their military heads; they talked and came up with a solution.

This latest debacle is only one drop in our mutual bucket of pain and suffering because of greed and the continual drive to maintain power and control by the few. As millions of Ukrainian refugees pour into surrounding countries, they are welcomed by the West while millions of refugees from Syria, Yemen, Palestine, Sudan, the Congo and so many other non-white areas, languish in camps where rape and lack of adequate food, water and shelter prevail; where some have lived for decades as non-citizens of anywhere and therefore not entitled to any supports or considerations. And the West refuses to take them, while providing minuscule funds to help the overwhelmed nations that house and try to feed them. Why is there such a disparity in the response? The Democratic West loudly spouts that we are non-discriminatory, that we value all humanity—so why are Ukraine refugees fast tracked into Canada while others take years to be processed, if at all.

I am not excusing or justifying Russia's invasion of Ukraine but reminding us that there is always more than one side to every coin, every action has a back story, a history. It takes more than one person, whether Putin, Biden, Zelinsky, Freeland, or Trudeau, to create a war, to decide to destroy a country or a people. The system of conflict, of one up man ship, of greed, of self righteousness, of lies, deceit and propaganda, of military might is right, is so ingrained that it will take a concerted effort by we, the people, to say NO MORE, NO MORE WAR, I WILL NOT KILL, I WILL NOT SUPPORT THOSE WHO DO CREATE WAR!

Are we prepared to do that? I wish and pray and hope we are. But, when a 9 year old accuses another of being evil because their ancestors came from Russia, then we do have a major problem. The only way we will stop the carnage of death and destruction sanctioned, allowed, encouraged, supported by governments is when the people have had enough and stop buying into the propaganda, when the dichotomy of evil and good, the finger pointing that my nation has clean hands and yours does not stops, when soldiers trained to kill are no longer lauded as heroes. When a middle power such as Canada and small players like Ukraine are no longer willing to be used by the big powers such as the USA, Russia, China and others in their quest for dominance, then we will begin to come out from under the yoke of war. {The incident of the 9 year old happened to my Granddaughter. She came home wondering if she responded correctly to this classmate that yesterday was a friend. She said, I am not Russian, I am a Doukhobor. We are pacifists so do not kill anyone.}

We the people of the world must accept the responsibility of enabling and perpetrating this behaviour. When the majority begins to stop reacting to nationalist and populist propaganda, when we begin to live true peace every day, when we stop supporting violence by nations and military alliances, when we look at our planet as one world filled with family, when we live respecting and honouring each being on this planet, when we truly value and stop destroying Mother Earth that is when war and conflict and all violence will cease. Until then we must continue to work to bring forward the truth that war is never the answer, that violence and abuse only beget more violence and abuse, that destruction breeds anger and hate.

Why do we find it so hard to step out of the shadow of violence and war? Why do we find it so hard to treat each other with respect and love? Why do we find it so hard to be kind and thoughtful and generous? Why is it so hard to love our neighbour? Why is it so difficult to live peace?

It is up to each of us. Only I can make the decision for myself not to fight, not to enable the military industrial complex, not to enable the destruction of our planet, not to kill and maim people, not to support or act with discrimination, racism, superiority complexes and self-righteousness. Only I can decide for myself if I support the most current war between the visible players Russia and Ukraine. Only I can decide for myself, if I support those selling weapons to one side or the other or goading one side or the other to continue the murder and destruction.

Are you ready to evaluate your decision? If you decide that you do not support violence of any form, do not support any war efforts, any military actions, then we can break the chains of hate, of fear, of violence of which war is the ultimate expression. Let's join our energies, join our hearts and minds, let's join hands and walk the talk of socio-economic justice and equity, of treating all with integrity and dignity, of living a vibrant peace with love for all Creation. We can if we put our minds to it! Are we ready this Mother's Day to stand for true peaceful living in harmony with our global family?
